

**SUMITOMO MACHINERY CORP. OF AMERICA (SMA) EXPORT CONTROL POLICY**

The United States has a statutory and regulatory system for controlling and monitoring the movement of goods and technology. The system is designed to uphold the commitments of the United States to a multilateral export control regime and to minimize the risks to the national security of the United States.

It is the policy of SMA to fully comply with all laws and regulations governing the export of its products, services, software and technical data. Diversion contrary to U.S. law is prohibited. In addition, commodities may not be exported, re-exported, or re-transmitted to entities and persons that are ineligible under U.S. law to receive U.S. product, technology and/or software.

We respectfully request our customers to sign this blanket agreement to comply with the export control laws of the U.S. with regard to the exportation of the Equipment and any other products or technology of SMA and any associated technical data. These commodities may not be exported, re-exported or re-transferred to entities or persons that are ineligible under U.S. law.
